TAXATION OF COSTS

On January 30, 2007 Judgment was entered in favor of the defendant, G.E. Medical Systems Information Technologies, Inc., and against the plaintiff, Christopher A. Roller. On March 5, 2007 the defendant filed a Bill of Costs. No objections to the defendant's Bill of Costs have been filed. The defendant has requested reimbursement for court reporter expenses, the expense of copies and for docket fees.

The Clerk finds that the \$2,008.60 requested for court reporter fees is reasonable and allowable as a cost in this case. The Clerk finds that the \$951.26 requested for copy expenses are reasonable and allowable as a cost in this case. The Clerk finds that the docket fees relate to expenses incurred in state court and are not allowable as a cost in this case.

Costs are hereby taxed in favor of the defendant; G.E. Medical Systems Information Technologies, Inc., and against the plaintiff; Christopher A. Roller, in the amount of \$2,959.86.
