**OPPOSITION TO REPORT AND
RECOMMENDATION**

INTRODUCTION

I can see where there was some confusion. So many wrongs were done, I lumped the claim amount for all the alleged violations. I believe the judge misunderstood my claims and the damages I am seeking. To itemize, I am seeking \$5 trillion for conspiracy to commit fraud (MN § 609.05 (6) as the claim for relief), and \$5 billion for medical malpractice. Since \$5 billion is 1/1000 of \$5 trillion, I did not itemize the figure but instead rounded the total amount. I appreciate the judge allowing me to "get it right", because dismissing this case would truly be a tragedy considering what Sioux Valley did to me. Much of the following information is repeated from previous dockets.

ARGUMENTS

MN § 609.05 Liability for crimes of another.

Subdivision 1. Aiding, abetting; liability. A person is criminally liable for a crime committed by another if the person intentionally aids, advises, hires, counsels, or conspires with or otherwise procures the other to commit the crime.

Sioux Valley participated in aiding and abetting to concealing godly powers with

the mob, and accessory and accomplice for fraud in covering up the alleged poisoning.

MN § 541.34 Existing and future claims.

Sections 541.30 to 541.35 apply to claims arising from incidents occurring on or after August 1, 2004.

I can apply MN § 541.31 to the defendant because the discovery of the fraud (David Copperfield using godly powers) occurred after August 1, 2004, on June 15, 2005.

MN § 541.05 Various cases, six years.

(6) for relief on the ground of fraud, in which case the cause of action shall not be deemed to have accrued until the discovery by the aggrieved party of the facts constituting the fraud;

Fraud - intentional deception resulting in injury to another person

Fraud (Encarta)-the crime of obtaining money or some other benefit by deliberate deception

Fraud - something intended to deceive; deliberate trickery intended to gain an advantage

The deliberate deception has been in hiding godly powers while injuring me in a cover-up. This statute gives me 6 years to file this suit from the discovery of the fraud - June 15, 2005, from the David Copperfield suit (05-446 JRT/FLN).

Perhaps the judge is unaware of the crippling behavior of people who don't appreciate me and my web site. Please see Type 9 people. These are the people

who are committing fraud against me, including Sioux Valley's doctors. It can be confusing to understand what type 9 is or who they are. George Bush, for example, is type 9. See case 05-2177 and how deceptive type 9 people can be. Type 9 are trying to make me into a false prophet by calling me crazy and breaking laws while doing it. They claim they care about me when in fact they don't.

Medical Malpractice

There is some confusion about not stating an amount for the medical malpractice. I am seeking \$5 billion for medical malpractice. Since \$5 billion is 1/1000 of \$5 trillion, I did not itemize the figure but instead rounded the total amount to \$5 trillion.

\$5 billion qualifies for greater than \$75,000, and diversity (out of state) qualifies as subject matter jurisdiction.

CONCLUSION

I oppose the report and recommendation. MN § 541.31, MN § 541.05, and MN § 541.15 meet the requirements for extensions of limitations and application of SD to MN statutes, and gives me the ability to litigate action against anyone from any state who has committed fraud against me. This qualifies as personal and subject matter jurisdiction, and \$5 trillion in compensation for aiding and abetting (MN § 609.05 Sub 1) fraud against me as the claim for relief; and \$5 billion as compensation for medical malpractice claim. Please don't dismiss this case.
