
ORDER

MEMORANDUM

1. Background.

The trial judge assigned to this case was forwarded a copy of the four pages attached to this Order directly by the Redwood County Court Administrator. The customary practice of intercepting such information before the Judge was not followed. Because the materials were sent directly to me by the Court Administrator, the trial judge has received these items.

I necessarily read a portion of the documents, as I was not aware that they had been forwarded inappropriately by the Court Administrator.

2. The Customary Procedure.

There are a number of basic principles of law that apply associated with a case assigned to a particular judge. The judge assigned to the case is not to have ex parte contact with any litigant or counsel for any litigant. The Court is not to have ex parte conversations or private exchanges about the issues before the Court, the merits of a particular position, or the lack of merits of a particular position.

All parties are to have equal access to the judge assigned to the case. No one is permitted to convey information to the court that is not equally conveyed to all others, with an opportunity for all others to be heard on the issue presented to the judge. With some exceptions, all proceedings occur in the courtroom.

3. Analysis.

I cannot "unread" the materials that were filed by Mr. Roller and forwarded directly to me by the Redwood County Court Administrator. I can forward to counsel and Defendant this Order outlining the rules that apply and disclose the improper contact that I believe has occurred.

It is not proper for me to respond to the submissions of Mr. Roller without affording his attorney, as well as the attorney for the State an opportunity to review and comment on the materials submitted.

As the judge assigned to the case, I will not, unless raised by the parties in open court with appropriate notice to the other parties, address the undated letter or any of the attachments (some of which have not been read) submitted by Mr. Roller.

Prospectively, the Court Administrator shall not forward to me ex parte correspondence submitted by Mr. Roller, associated with this matter.

The Defendant is absolutely entitled to file with the court such filings as he may deem appropriate as provided by Minnesota law, however, filings cannot be ex parte. The judge cannot give legal advice to a party in this litigation. Mr. Roller is encouraged to discuss any concerns he may have associated with the case with his attorney and to submit filings through his attorney.

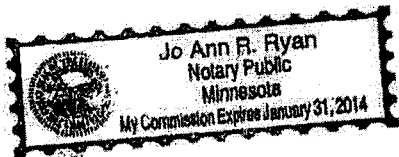

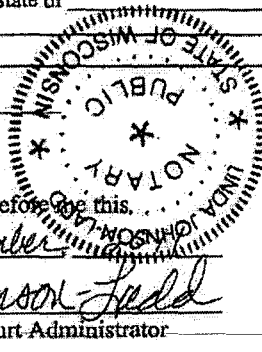
