The Complainant, being duly sworn, makes complaint to the above-named Court and states that there is probable cause to believe that the Defendant committed the following offense(s):

Count 1

Terroristic Threats-Reckless Disregard Risk

In Violation Of: 609.713 subd. 1

Penalty: 5 years imprisonment, a \$10,000 fine, or both

CHRISTOPHER ANTHONY ROLLER did, on or about July 14, 2011, in Redwood County, Minnesota, directly or indirectly threaten to commit any crime of violence with the purpose to terrorize another or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror. To wit: Defendant threatened to shoot B.J.D.

Count 2

Stalking - Aggravated Violations - Tamper w/Juror, Retaliate Against Judicial Officer

In Violation Of: 609.749 subd. 3(a)(4); 609.749 subd. 3(a)

Penalty: 5 years imprisonment, a \$10,000 fine, or both

CHRISTOPHER ANTHONY ROLLER did, on or about July 14, 2011, in Redwood County, Minnesota, directly or indirectly, or through third parties, manifest a purpose or intent to injure the person, property, or rights of another by the commission of an unlawful act and did so with the intent to influence or otherwise tamper with with a juror or a judicial proceeding or with intent to retaliate against a judicial officer, as defined in section 609.415, or a prosecutor, defense attorney, or officer of the court, because of that person's performance of official duties in connection with a judicial proceeding.

Count 3**Disorderly Conduct-Offensive/Abusive/Noisy/Obscene****In Violation Of: 609.72 subd. 1(3); 609.72 subd. 1****Penalty: 90 days in jail, a \$1,000 fine, or both**

CHRISTOPHER ANTHONY ROLLER did, on or about July 14, 2011, in Redwood County, Minnesota, wrongfully and unlawfully engage in offensive, obscene, abusive, boisterous, or noisy conduct or in offensive, obscene, or abusive language tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger, or resentment in others in a public or private place, knowing, or having reasonable grounds to know that it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The Complainant states that the following facts establish probable cause:

Officer Mike Hubin is a licensed peace officer in the State of Minnesota, presently employed by the Redwood County Sheriffs Office. His duties include the enforcement of laws and the investigation of criminal activity occurring in Redwood County, Minnesota. During the course of the investigation of this matter, Deputy Hubin has done one or more of the following: confer with witnesses, review witness statements, confer with officers, and/or observe physical evidence.

On July 14, 2011, at approximately 3:10 p.m., Deputies Schoepfer and Hubin of the Redwood County Sheriff's Office responded to the Redwood County Courthouse and spoke to Redwood County Court Administration staff member B.J.D. about threatening comments that were recently made to her over the telephone. B.J.D. provided Deputy Hubin with the following information. A caller identified as CHRISTOPHER ANTHONY ROLLER, date of birth 06/14/1967, ("Defendant" hereinafter) called court administration (B.J.D.) and wanted to know information about harassment restraining orders that he had filed which were being dismissed by the court. Defendant repeatedly demanded to know why the orders were dismissed. Defendant made comments to B.J.D. including stating that the orders were being dismissed because Defendant "was God" and "they are intimidated." Defendant told B.J.D. that he was getting pissed off. Defendant specifically named three judges who have apparently dealt with Defendant in the past. B.J.D. attempted to advise Defendant on how to make complaints about judges if he was disappointed with how the judges had been treating him. Defendant again indicated that he was "pissed off" and then said to B.J.D., "What do I have to do to their attention, shoot a judge?" In response, B.J.D. advised Defendant that she was going to hang up on Defendant. Defendant then stated "I'm not done yet" and said something along the lines of, "do I have to get your attention, come up there and shoot you too?" B.J.D. then terminated the telephone call and reported the incident shortly after discussing it with a coworker. Two judges referenced during the call were also notified of the threat.

Deputies Schoepfer and Hubin went to a residence in the city of Redwood Falls in an effort to contact Defendant. Defendant answered the door. Deputies asked Defendant to step outside and advised Defendant that he was being arrested under suspicion of Terroristic Threats and Disorderly Conduct. Deputies described Defendant as acting defensive and belligerent at this time. Deputies eventually transported Defendant to the Redwood County Law Enforcement Center.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

RELEASE WITH CONDITIONS

Defendant shall be released upon:

- Personally promising to obey all of the RELEASE CONDITIONS
- Posting a secured bond or cash bail in the amount of ~~25,000.00~~ \$ 25,000.00

or
~~Posting a cash deposit as bail in the amount of _____ accompanied by a written bail bond notice with the Court Administrator and acceptable to the Judge securing the defendant's appearance.~~

In all of the above cases, the defendant shall obey the following RELEASE CONDITIONS:

- Appear at all future court hearings
- Be of good behavior and obey all laws of the United States and the State of Minnesota
- Not leave the State of Minnesota without Court permission
- Report any address changes to the Court Administrator and defendant's attorney, if any
- Complete all required booking procedures today.
- Contact and stay in contact with your attorney
- No unnecessary contact with witnesses
- Totally abstain from the use of alcohol and drugs unless prescribed for you by your physician. You shall not enter bars or liquor stores. The defendant shall submit to random drug or alcohol testing by probation or law enforcement.

The Defendant shall report ___ daily / ___ times weekly to the probation agent for testing. Two tests per week shall be at the Defendant's expense and additional tests at the expense of law enforcement/probation.

- No direct or indirect contact with BSD or with and stay 100 yards from their residence.
- Other: Judges Peterson, Dietrich or Hannelson

He is excluded from the Redwood County Courthouse except for
